Western Canada

As of June 12 - Vancouver ports dock workers union voted 99.24% to support strike action

The earliest notification of strike action will be June 21, 2023, with a potential work stoppage on June 24th.

As of July 13th - The Labour Union ULWU and have tentatively agreement to a new 4 year Labour agreement. Please note that until the agreement is ratified the state of the Port is being monitored.

As of July 14 2023 there are no major issues in Western Canada.

Vessel arrivals at the Port of Vancouver will updated as the Port of Vancouver begins operations and delays are expected on all orders.

Transit times from Vancouver Port to Winnipeg are still high at 4-5 weeks from the port of Vancouver

Domestic Orders are not experience any major delays

Eastern Canada

Currently no vessel congestion at Port of Montreal

With the potential for strike again in Vancouver the Montreal and Halifax ports will begin to see escalated volumes

Transit time from the Port of Montreal to Winnipeg 3-4 weeks

California/US

With the transition from DHL to Hillebrand in February 2023 – no issues have been advised Currently issues in California or Shipping from the USA to

Approximately \$150,000.00 of backlogged invoices were billed out June 2021 – 2023

Argentina / Chile

Due to the strike action in Vancouver through late June and July all vessels in transit are potentially delayed and may have omitted Vancouver.

All orders through Vancouver will monitored as Vessel ETA's are updated.

Russian Sanctions still in place for exporting from Russia

Ukraine is still under an act of war declaration so shipping from Ukraine to Canada is on hold

Monitoring issues in France and Germany as Rhine river is continuing to experience low water levels. The low water levels are putting strains on alternate transportation options.

New Zealand

New Zealand's port services are returning to normal. No major delays.

Service out of South Africa remains stable, but with extended lead times due to limited marine carrier options.
