

As part of MBLL's ongoing efforts to share tips on using CSS more efficiently please see today's tip below regarding the Reprice Order Button in CSS.


BDL has recently adjusted its minimum order threshold to 70 dozen cases, allowing for the waiver of the \$75 Delivery Fee. Similarly, other distributors such as WETT SALES and FORT GARRY BREWING have implemented comparable minimum order requirements.

As you continue to place orders through CSS, it is crucial to pay attention to the Order Qty and Distributor fields, denoting the number of cases requested and the specific distributor, respectively, to fulfill the minimum requirements.




CSS provides a helpful tool on the Shopping Cart screen, indicating whether you have met the minimum requirements for each distributor. The REPRICE ORDER button will detail any additional fees, including delivery fees, that will be applied to your current order. If the delivery fee is present, this provides an opportunity to adjust your order to meet the minimum requirement and consequently waive the delivery fee. (See Below)
