RE: **NOTIFICATION OF THE CANADA–UNITED STATES–MEXICO AGREEMENT (CUSMA)**

Effective July 1, 2020 the Canada-United States-Mexico Agreement (CUSMA) is scheduled to come into force. This agreement replaces the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA). Manitoba Liquor and Lotteries will honour any existing NAFTA Certificates of Origin or Origin Declarations currently on file under the new trade agreement.

The following countries have a trade agreement with Canada under the CUSMA:

- U.S.A., Puerto Rico and Mexico

We have updated our Origin Declaration Worksheet to reflect the new requirements. Going forward please ensure you are using the updated Origin Declaration Worksheet and submit with the Certificate of Origin or Origin Declaration Documentation. Certificate of Origin documentation will only be accepted for the period of January 1-December 31(calendar year).

Reminder:

- We require exporter/suppliers, not agents, to complete, sign and submit the applicable certificate
 - Origin Declarations from an agent representing the exporter or supplier will not be accepted
- All submissions must be completed electronically, paper submissions will not be accepted
 - Please send all documentation to: certificatesoforigin@mbll.ca
- Products submitted must be an active listing with MBLL at the time of Origin Declaration
- Incomplete submissions will not be accepted
