



HOW TO CLEAN VLT EQUIPMENT

(after every use)

CLEANING A VLT



STEPS:

- 1 SPRAY CLEANER ONTO CLEAN, SOFT CLOTH
- 2 USE DAMPENED CLOTH TO WIPE:
 - ALL SURFACES ON THE FRONT OF THE TERMINAL
 - THE SURFACE ON EACH SIDE OF THE TERMINAL
- 3 ALLOW 60 SECONDS FOR CLEANER TO AIR-DRY ON VLT
- 4 USE DRY, MICROFIBRE CLOTH TO REMOVE STREAKS / CLEANING RESIDUE

VLT CLEANING PRODUCT MUST:

- CONTAIN 70% ALCOHOL (MIN.)
- NOT CONTAIN AMMONIA (AMMONIA WILL DAMAGE TERMINAL)
- NEVER BE SPRAYED DIRECTLY ON VLT
- NEVER BE ALLOWED TO PENETRATE ANY PART OF THE VLT
- BE PROVIDED BY SITEHOLDER

NOTE: UNSCENTED LYSOL/CLOROX DISINFECTANT WIPES CAN BE USED

CLEANING A VLT CHAIR



STEPS:

- 1 GENTLY SPRITZ CHAIR WITH CLEANER
- 2 ALLOW CLEANER TO REMAIN ON CHAIR FOR 60 SECONDS
- 3 USE DRY CLOTH TO REMOVE DAMPNESS / CLEANING RESIDUE

CHAIR CLEANING PRODUCT MUST:

- (HARD-SURFACE CHAIRS) CONTAIN 70% ALCOHOL (MIN.)
- (SOFT-SURFACE CHAIRS) BE AN APPROVED PRODUCT FOR USE ON FABRIC
- BE PROVIDED BY SITEHOLDER
